Recommended Rezoning to Inst-2 with Covenant:

This means there must be some kind of substantive permanent physical improvement installed on/in the property, in accordance with plans approved by all appropriate departments and agencies, by the end of the day February 9, 2020. If not, the property will automatically revert; the proposed development will no longer be a permitted use; and a re-rezoning of the property will be necessary before any further work can be done on the development in question. Also, please note that simply having approved plans, a building permit, clearing the site of vegetation or even performing excavation on the property does not satisfy this requirement: there must be actual construction underway on the site.
