It is therefore hereby **ORDERED** and **DIRECTED** as follows:

- 1. The Presiding Judge of the Tenth Judicial Circuit of Alabama has determined that all Unified Judicial System Courts, Circuit and District, and all Clerk's Offices within the Tenth Judicial Circuit of Alabama, Birmingham and Bessemer Divisions, will be closed on **Tuesday**, **February 16**, **2021** and shall reopen open **Wednesday**, **February 17**, **2021** at **8:00** a.m.
- 2. Over this period, the Clerk's Office is hereby directed to maintain sufficient staff on hand, as in the discretion of the Circuit Clerk of the Tenth Judicial Circuit of Alabama, to handle any emergency, civil or criminal, that may arise on February 16, 2021.
